### Description

The Dandelion is a very common herbaceous plant that grows in fields, gardens and virtually everywhere. It is so widespread that some people consider it a weed. However, the Dandelion is a plant with uncountable botanical properties. Different parts of the Dandelion can be used, each one providing a different array of bioactive components. The roots are rich in Inulin and Mucilage. The aerial parts are rich in Flavonoids. Drasanvi capsules use the aerial parts of the Dandelion, yielding 10% of Flavonoids which help to restore the liver and gallbladder functions.

Dandelion Dry Extract *Taraxacum officinale Weber Ratio 15:1, providing Flavonoids (10%)* 300 mg, Casing *(Hydroxypropyl Methylcellulose)*, Bulking agent *(Microcrystalline Cellulose)*, Bulking agent *(Magnesium Stereate)*, Anti-caking agent *(Silicon Dioxide)* 

**Directions** Presentation

Take one (1) capsule daily with breakfast.

### Additional Information

#### **Dry Extract**

Our Dandelion capsules contain dry extracts instead of powdered plant material. Dry extracts are more concentrated and therefore, fewer product amounts can achieve the same results. We have selected a Dandelion Extract rich in Vitamin C. "Dry extract" refers to a specific extraction process that retains the bioactive compounds from plant materials and eliminates impurities and other unnecessary substances. The use of plant extracts has several advantages over the use of powdered forms:

- 1. The bioactive compounds content can be accurately measured (Standardized Extracts).
- 2. Products based on plant extracts are more concentrated that those made from powdered plant material (Concentrated and easy to take doses).
- 3. The assimilation of bioactive compounds is easier if they are isolated (extract form) rather than in combination with the rest of plant material that retains impurities and fiber (powdered form).

#### Standardised Extracts

Another important advantage of our product formulation is the use of standardised extracts. Standardised extracts contain isolated, guaranteed amounts of bioactive ingredients that remain constant over time. In this particular case, we use the aerial parts of the Dandelion which are titrated in Flavonoids, ensuring a constant daily dose of 30 mg.

#### Concentrated and easy to take dose

The use of concentrated and titrated dry extracts allows for the delivery of the same amount in just one (1) dose.

#### Vegetable-based capsules

Our capsules are vegetable-based. They are manufactured from Hydroxypropyl Methylcellulose, which is a product derived from plant cellulose. These capsules have been certified by the Vegetarian Society.

#### Free from Allergens

We make every effort to ensure that our Dandelion capsules are free of the most common allergens, in particular gluten.

#### **Blister packs**

Our Dandelion capsules come in blister packs. Blister packs protect products against adverse external influences that may affect its quality or potency (such as mechanical damage and environmental factors like moisture or biological contamination), ensuring their composition for extended periods of time.
