



Garlic Macerate 500 mg 90 Softgels Nutrabasics Drasanvi

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Description

Garlic is a plant widely used in Mediterranean culture. Cuisine and tradition have taken advantage of its **flavour and its properties**. The characteristic flavour and smell of Garlic is due to its composition: **Allicin, Phosphorus, Silicon and Vitamins of group B**, a flavour that often hinders its consumption in raw. Drasanvi presents the pearls of Garlic Macerate in oil, coated with gelatin, for a more pleasant intake and without losing the benefits of the plant.

Ingredients

Garlic Macerate Oil (*Bulb*) (*Allium sativum L.*, *Allicin 0,05%*) 1.500 mg, Coating agent (*Gelatin and Glycerin*)

Directions

Take three (3) softgels a day spread over the main meals.

Presentation

Bottle with 90 softgels of 700 mg. Total Weight: 63 g (2.22 oz).

Warnings

Food supplements should not be used as a substitute for a balanced diet. Do not exceed the expressly recommended daily dose. Keep out of the reach of little kids. Store in a cool, dry place. Standardized Oils

One of the most important advantages in our formulation is the use of standardized extracts. This means that the active ingredients are constant over time. In the case of Garlic Oil, it is titled in Allicin, contributing 0,75 mg per daily dose.

Macerated Garlic

The Garlic that we incorporate in our softgels is macerated in oil. This is the only form of Garlic in which the active ingredients are present in significant amounts (ajoenes and vinyl dithiins).

Concentrated dose and easy to take

The use of concentrated and titrated oils allows us to obtain the same dose in three softgels.

Allergen Free

Macerated Garlic Oil softgels are made so that there is no contamination with any of the most frequent allergens, among which we highlight gluten.
